Requirements for Becoming a Kinderbadger:

Self-Help

- Manages bathroom needs independently
- Washes own hands
- Can walk around the block or home from the park by himself
- Puts on/takes off own jacket and shoes (including buttons, zippers, laces, belt)
- Cleans up toys after playing
- Cleans up self and table after snack/lunch time

Social

- Understands actions have consequences
- Begins to share with others and take turns
- Recognizes and respects authority
- Can focus on a task for 10 minutes
- Separates easily from parents
- Listens without interrupting
- Respects others' space and property

Fine & Gross Motor Skills

- Traces basic shapes and lines
- Writes own name
- Walks up and down stairs alternating feet
- Writes/colors with 3-finger grip

Reading & Math

- Can recite the alphabet
- Can count to 10
- Is familiar with all letters and numerals
- Identifies own name
- *Identifies letters A-Z*
- Identifies numerals 0-9

Miscellaneous:

- Speaks when spoken to 100% of the time
- Speaks loud enough so as to be heard
- Recites in a group
- Comfortable singing aloud
- Is accustomed to discipline
- Asks for help
- Can follow multi-step directions
- Can memorize a short rhyme or Bible verse
- Makes eye contact when speaking
- Participates willingly in new activities
